2 General Information

This document describes how to update the firmware of VideoPoster-III.

Name of the firmware update file:

setup_VideoPoster-III_Firmware_PA-26-XXX_vV.E.R_V1.bin "V.E.R" is a placeholder for the new firmware version number (e.g. "1.2.0")

It can be installed on the following board configurations:

ATTENTION:

The power supply for VideoPoster-III must NOT be interrupted during the firmware installation because this can damage the product!

The VideoPoster-III restarts after the firmware installation automatically. This is normal behavior

Preparations before the firmware update:

- Download the firmware zip file "VideoPoster-III_Firmware_PA-26-XXX_vV.E.R_V1.zip" from our homepage and save it on your computer.

- Extract the contained firmware file and install this on your VideoPoster-III as described in the next section



3 Firmware Update Guide

The new firmware can be installed on VideoPoster-III by using one of the following methods:

3.1 Upload the new Firmware via Web Interface

- Open the web interface of VideoPoster-III
- Select the menu "Advanced"
- Browse the firmware update file in the section "Firmware Update" and press the button "Upload to VideoPoster-III"
- Wait up to 10 minutes and consider the messages in your browser until the installation has finished

3.2 Upload the new Firmware via USB Flash Drive

- Copy the firmware update file into the root directory of an empty USB flash drive
- Insert the USB flash drive into the USB port of your VideoPoster-III
- Read the status messages on the display
- Wait up to 10 minutes until the installation has finished
- Verify if the installation was successful. To do so, insert the USB flash drive into a PC and open the log-file called "setup_VideoPoster-III_Firmware_PA-26-XXX_vV.E.R_V1.log". Check the messages in this log file. For a successful update the last line states: "Update complete, current FW version is V.E.R.S"

3.3 Upload the new Firmware via ACC 3.x

- Open the Windows software ACC version 3.22 or above
- Select the tab "Device Manager"
- Select the device you want to update (must be added to the "**Device Manager**" before)
- Open the context menu of the device (right click on the device)
- Select the menu entry "Upload Setup File to Device"
- Browse the firmware update file
- Press the "**OK**" button in the appearing dialog to upload the file to the device
- Wait up to 10 minutes until the installation has finished with a "Success" message

3.4 Download the new Firmware from an FTP Server

- Configure the VideoPoster-III to poll playlists from a FTP server (this can be done in the web interface in menu "**Content Auto Update**")
- Create the folders "setup" and "log" in the playlist directory on the FTP server
- Upload the firmware update file to the "**setup**" directory by using ACC 3 or a standard FTP client (e.g. FileZilla)
- When next polling interval of VideoPoster-III occurs, it downloads the firmware update file and installs it automatically
- The installation of the new firmware takes up to 10 minutes
- Verify if the installation was successful. To do so, open the log-file called "XX-XX-Setup_VideoPoster-III_Firmware_PA-26-XXX_vV.E.R_V1.log" in the log directory on the FTP server (XX-XX-XX is a placeholder for a unique prefix representing the last 3 digits of the MAC address of VideoPoster-III). Check the messages in this log file. For a successful update it states: "Successfully applied setup package!"
